Financial Report of 2003/2004

1.1 Salary and Allowances Received

The salary of a Senator is \$102, 760 per annum.

In addition, each Senator or Member is paid an Electorate Allowance for expenses which are necessarily incurred in the performance of the Senator's duty. This allowance is \$27 300. The Electorate Allowance is provided to assist with work-related expenses, but any amount left unspent may be retained by the MP personally.

It is the policy of the Greens to spend the whole amount on work expenses.

1.2 Details on how allowances were spent

Attached is a statement detailing how Senator Nettle's Electorate Allowance for the 03/04 financial year was spent.

1.3 Details of Staffing Resources

Senator Nettle may engage four full-time staff to assist in carrying out her parliamentary and electorate responsibilities.

In addition, Senator Nettle has used her Relief Staff Budget and her Electorate Allowance to employ additional part time staff.
